- Kiosk highlighting the history of Durham Catholic schools and Distinguished Catholic Alumni

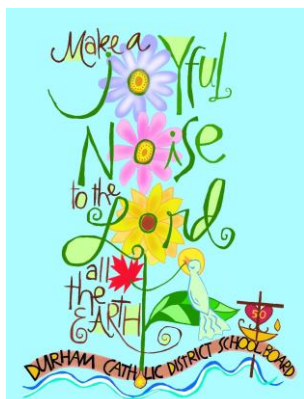
## A History of the Durham Catholic District School Board

## Update from Anne O'Brien, Director of Education



Director O'Brien welcomed everyone to the Year of Joy and the board's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary year, highlighting a transformational year for faith formation through [\*Renewing the Promise – A Pastoral Letter for Catholic Education\*](#).

The Director of Education thanked everyone who gathered for the annual Opening Mass followed by the first Regular Board Meeting of 2018. She extended special thanks to Father Laszlo Nagy, Pastor at Holy Family Catholic Parish for celebrating the Eucharist; and the choir for sharing their talents. She also thanked Dr. Bob Dixon for sharing his passion for history and his interest in the 50-year journey of the Durham Catholic District School Board to be chronicled in a book later this year.

Director O'Brien was delighted to visit staff for the school year startup with Chair Chapman, welcoming all to the Year of Joy, and expressing appreciation for the significant role they play in schools. She invited all staff and Trustees to the upcoming System-Wide Mass to launch the Year of Joy on Monday, October 1 at 4:30 p.m. at Holy Family Catholic Parish in Whitby. This day is in honour of World Teachers' Day which is formally recognized on October 5; National Custodial Workers' Day on October 2; and National Principals' Month throughout the month of October.

While other designated days will be celebrated across the board over the next several weeks, such as Franco-Ontarian Day, Orange Shirt Day and Early Childhood Education Appreciation Day, Director O'Brien highlighted Rowan's Law Day on September 26, 2018. On this day, new concussion safety legislation will be in effect to protect athletes and educate coaches about the dangers of head injuries. This law is the first of its kind in the country and was named [Rowan's Law](#), in memory of 17-year-old Rowan Stringer who died from rugby injuries.

Director O'Brien acknowledged correspondence from the Durham Region Health Department, recognizing 21 Durham Catholic schools for receiving gold, silver or bronze level Healthy School Awards. This recognition highlights a commitment to a Healthy Schools approach in the prevention of chronic diseases and injury. Congratulations to all award recipients.

The Director acknowledged and thanked staff, community partners and friends who continued to support the Durham Catholic Children's Foundation through various activities. Thank you to the organizers of the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Fore-the-Kids Golf Classic. Together over \$29,000 was raised for the board's most vulnerable students. "We look forward to building on this momentum in support of this and other important charities," she said.
